BLAST FROM THE PAST

Words are powerful, and they carry deep meaning, and used if incorrectly, they can cut like a sword.

"Hebrews 4: 12 For the Word of Elohim is living, and working, and sharper than any two-edged sword, cutting through even to the dividing of being and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart."

I was always taught to mind my words and think before speaking. The scriptures of Yahuah teaches us the same.

"Proverbs 18:21 Death and life are in the power of the tongue, And those loving it eat its fruit."

The origin and meaning behind words give us knowledge of what we speak and what is spoken to us, about us, or what truly governs us. Finding out the root word of Pharmacy is really what sealed the deal for me. I was in the medical field for about 10 years and this seemingly small piece of information is what halted my entire career.

Being in the medical field most of my work career, we were required to learn 'Medical Terminology'. Medical terminology provides a list of medical terms, abbreviations, and their meanings to give understanding and description of the human body and its components, sicknesses, procedures, and medication or drugs. Common word elements like roots, prefixes, and suffixes are used to construct most medical terms. While Prefixes don't appear in all medical terms, all medical terms end with a suffix, which usually indicates a specialty, test, procedure, function, condition/disorder, or status. For example:

Cardiology: 'Cardi' being the prefix or 'Cardio' being the root word, derives from the Greek word $\kappa\alpha\rho\delta(\alpha)$ (kardia) meaning 'heart'. And the suffix being '– ology' meaning 'The study of'. Putting these two affixes together creates the medical term 'Cardiology, The Study of The Heart'

But did you know the word Pharmacy, (where the world now looks to for medication aimed at healing) is also originated from a Greek word? With the Root word being φάρμἄκον (pharmakon/pharmakia) meaning Drug or medication, but it also means witchcraft or sorcery. So words like "Pharmacology" would mean means 'The study of drugs or medication and 'The study of witchcraft and sorcery'. All Medical terms are words made from ancient Greek and latin words and are defined as such also.

The Creator El Yahuah is very open about how He feels about witchcraft and sorcery. In His Torah, book of Leviticus chapter 19 verse 31, He states "Do not turn to mediums, and do not seek after spiritists/wizards to be defiled by them. I am Yahuah your Elohim". He is very clear.

'Exodus 22:18 "Do not allow a practitioner of witchcraft to live."'

Learning this changed EVERYTHING for me. Life got a lot harder, but my faith got a lot stronger! The word Pharamakia is even mentioned in the Greek translation of New Testament as sorcery. Being that it was written during Israel time in the Greek captivity, it's the language it was originally written in. It says that Babylon has led all nations astray with its 'Pharmakia' in Greek or 'sorcery' in English, Revelations 18:23. Like I said, this piece of information changed EVERYTHING!
